NCL hold the second Online Taiwan Lectures on Chinese Studies Series with Institute of Oriental Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences on November 26. The lecture given by Prof. Chih-yu Shih, entitled "In the Intellectual History of China Studies: Colonialism, Religion, and Their Post-Chinese Consequences".
